The meeting is likely to take place on 26-28<sup>th</sup> April 2017 in Jönköping, hosted by Jönköping University with the title 'English Across Borders'. Preparations are well in hand and keynote speakers will be confirmed shortly. A website for the meeting will be live in September 2016.
